Rapport annuel 2024





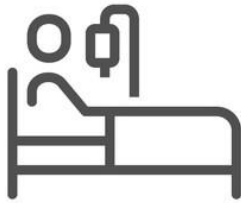
Durant l'année 2024, le bureau du CURCP est resté stable dans sa composition, à savoir une co-direction par la MER Dre Aline Bregou (CHUV) et le PD Dr Jacques Birraux (HUG), et pour les membres du bureau : les Prof Wildhaber, Prof Zambelli, MER Dr Lutz, PD Dr Dayer, PD Dre Calinescu et Dr Jauquier. La relève du bureau a commencé à être discutée. Madame Gorgerat en reste la fidèle secrétaire, toujours engagée à 20%.

Sur le plan clinique, les détails des activités sont détaillés sur les pages suivantes. On remarque une nette augmentation des consultations de chirurgie pédiatrique aux HUG, avec une stabilité globale des autres activités. Par ailleurs, les échanges entre site des chirurgiens se poursuivent de façon régulière dans les différentes disciplines. Selon les spécialités, des réunions cliniques partageant l'expérience et l'expertise se sont poursuivies, sans changement par rapport à l'année précédente.

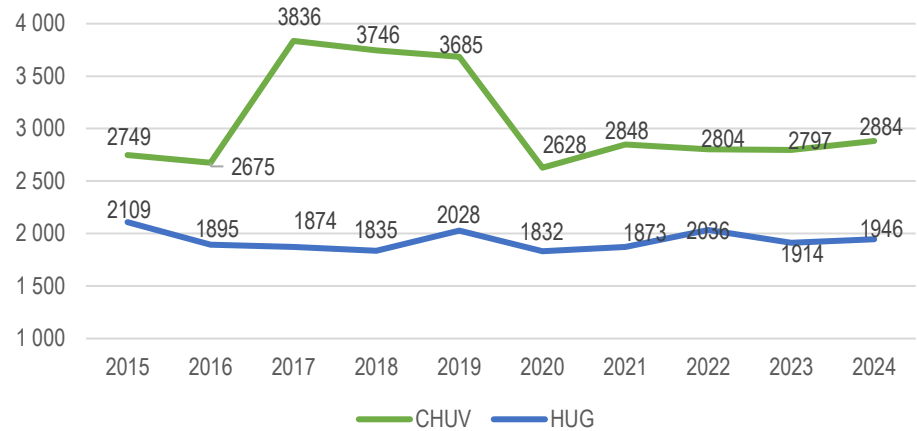
Nous avons pu faire une après-midi de formation le 26 septembre 2024. Nous avons opté pour des thèmes transversaux qui s'adressent aussi bien aux chirurgiens orthopédiques que viscéraux. Le thème abordé cette année a été celui des hémihypertrophies. Cette demi-journée, qui s'est terminée par un apéritif, puis une soirée commune des Internes et Chefs de Clinique, a été très appréciée. Nous avons prévu de renouveler ce genre d'évènement au moins une fois par année, afin de permettre de créer aussi des liens non professionnels entre les jeunes membres du CURCP.

Du point de vue académique et de l'enseignement l'activité a continué à un bon niveau. Quarante-deux articles ont été publiés dans des revues spécialisées (peer review) internationales, permettant de donner une bonne visibilité au CURCP. Par ailleurs il y a eu de nombreuses présentations en Congrès, colloques et autres réunions tant au niveau suisse qu'international.

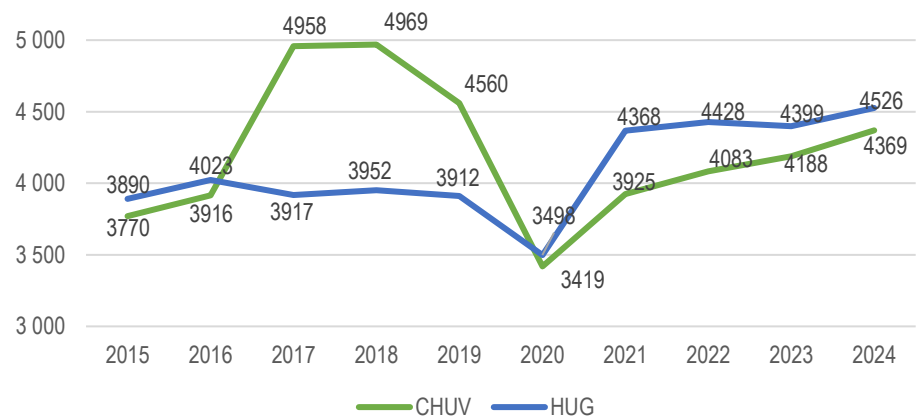

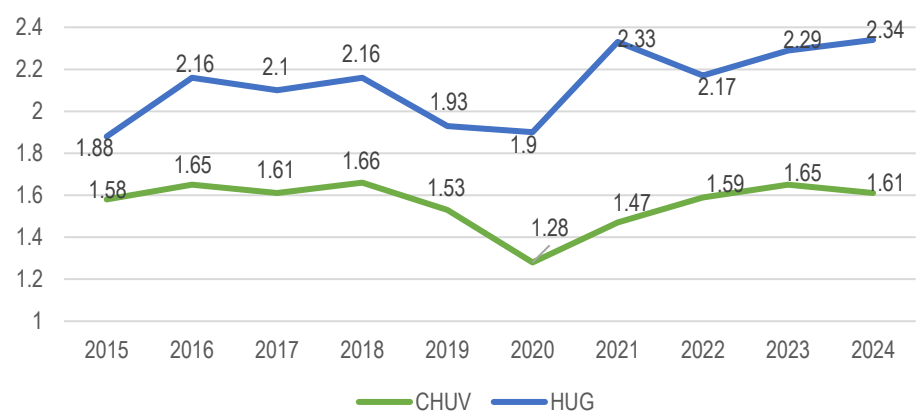
Patients opérés



Durée d'intervention totale (heure)

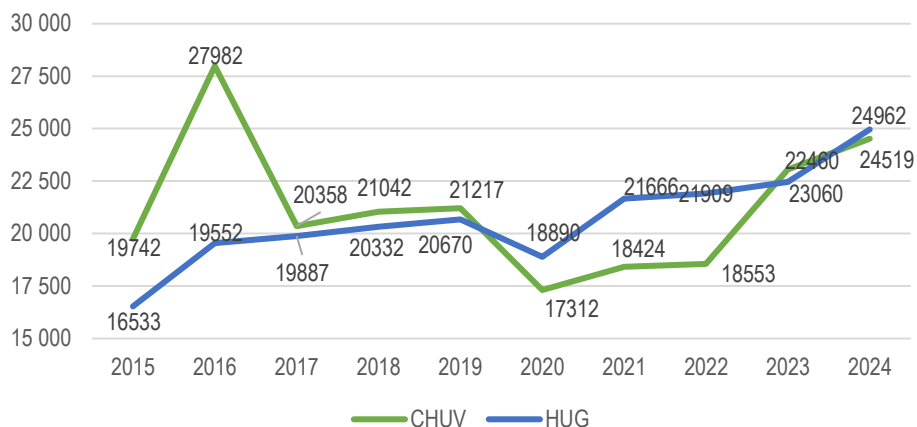


Durée d'intervention moyenne (heure)

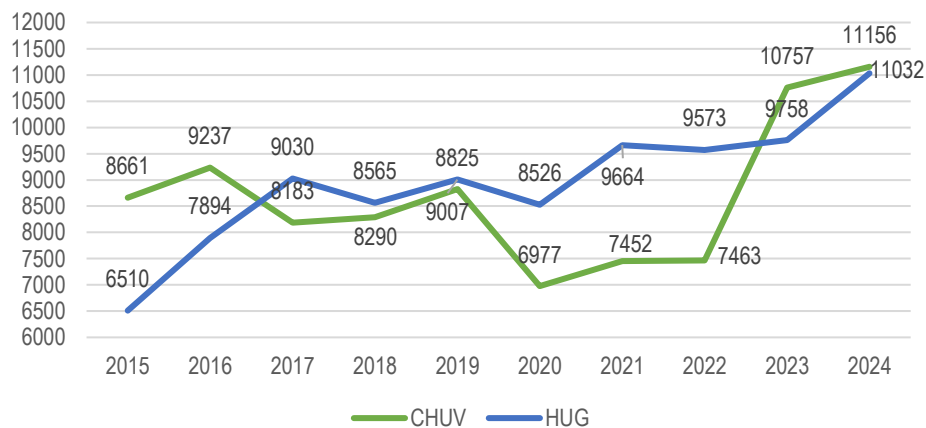




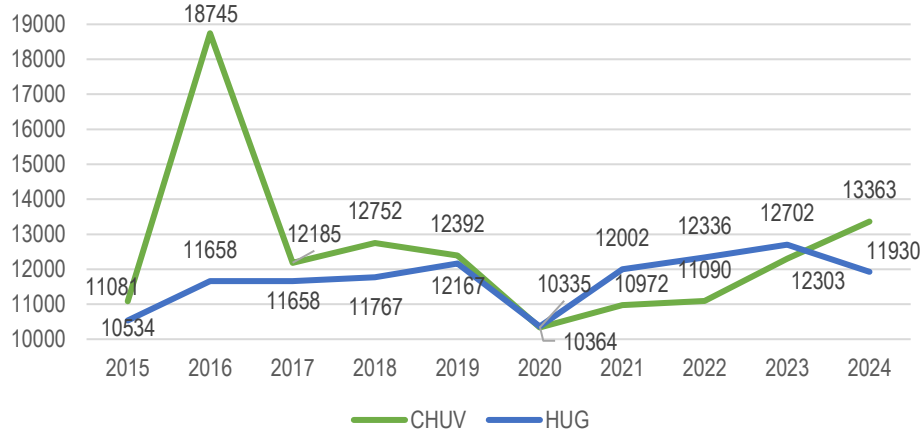
Nombre total des consultations
